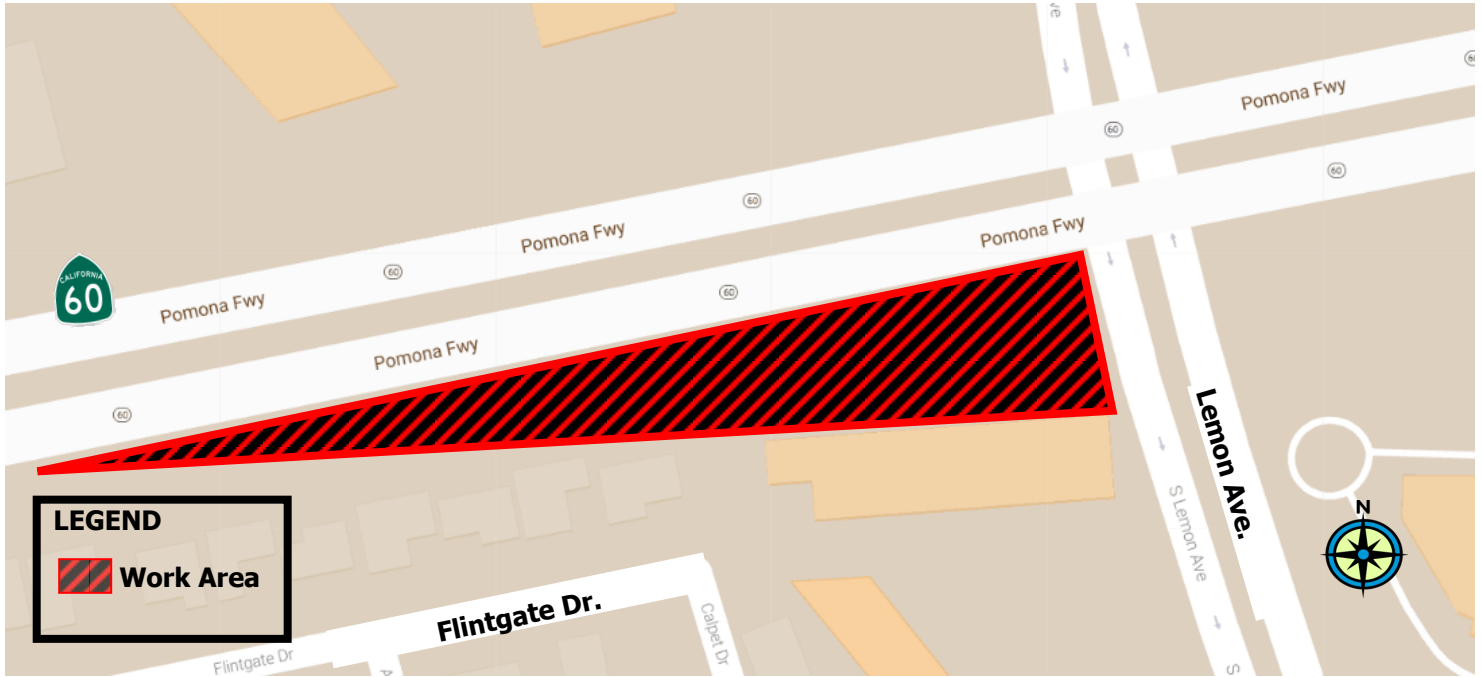




****CONSTRUCTION NOTICE****

CONSTRUCTION CONTINUES ON EASTBOUND OFF-RAMP OF SR-60/LEMON AVENUE INTERCHANGE PROJECT



WHAT

As part of the State Route 60/Lemon Avenue Interchange Project, the Alameda Corridor-East Construction Authority (ACE), on behalf of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and in conjunction with the Cities of Diamond Bar and Industry, will continue construction of an eastbound off-ramp on Lemon Avenue.

WHAT TO EXPECT

ACE contractors will begin mass excavation and installation of shoring in preparation for ramp construction. Crews will clear the work area of brush and trees. Some noise, dust and vibration may be noticeable. Access to local businesses and residences will be maintained. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to obey posted signs and to exercise caution while in the vicinity of construction activity.

WHEN

Work will begin on **Wednesday, March 22, 2017** and is expected to continue for approximately 6 months. Most work will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
