



****CONSTRUCTION ALERT****

TEMPORARY EVENING TRAFFIC LANE AND SIDEWALK CLOSURES ON RAILROAD STREET TO RELOCATE EXISTING AND INSTALL NEW UTILITY POLES



WHAT/WHERE

Southern California Edison will relocate existing and install new utility poles on Railroad Street (see map above). The work will include removal of existing wires and other utilities operating along the existing poles, and is required in advance of the Fullerton Road Grade Separation Project.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Traffic lanes will be temporarily and intermittently closed on portions of eastbound and westbound Railroad Street. One traffic lane will remain open in each direction at all times. A portion of the adjacent sidewalks will also be intermittently closed with pedestrian detours provided during construction. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Motorists and pedestrians are urged to obey posted signs and to exercise caution while in the vicinity of construction activity. Noise, dust and vibration will be monitored for compliance with applicable limits.

WHEN

Work will begin the evening of **Monday, May 23, 2016** and is expected to be completed by **Thursday, September 1, 2016**. To minimize traffic disruptions, work is being performed in phases and most work will occur from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Day work may be required and will occur from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Weekend work is not anticipated.
