MONTHS TO CONSTRUCT ROADWAY
UNDERPASS AT RAILROAD CROSSING

Project will eliminate train-vehicle collisions, traffic delay and train horn noise at hazardous railroad crossing

**WHAT**: Fairway Drive will be closed to traffic at the railroad crossing

immediately north of the State Route 60 Freeway in the City of Industry and unincorporated community of Rowland Heights for the next 36 months for construction by the Alameda Corridor-East Project (ACE) of a four-lane roadway underpass and four track railroad bridge to carry freight and Metrolink trains over Fairway Drive. The rail-roadway grade separation will reduce vehicle emissions and traffic congestion by an estimated 27.6 vehicle-hours of delay each day due to lowered gates at the crossing, which is traversed by 49 trains per day. The project will eliminate collisions, train horn noise and delays for emergency responders and improve safety. Seven collisions

emergency responders and improve safety. Seven collisions have been recorded at the Fairway Drive crossing over the past

10 years.

The road will be closed at approximately 9 p.m. on Thursday,

June 7, 2018.
