CONSTRUCTION ALERT TURNBULL CANYON ROAD GRADE SEPARATION PROJECT TO START JULY 2024 TO SUMMER 2027

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

Construction of the Turnbull Canyon Road Grade Separation Project will begin July 2024. The Turnbull Canyon Road Grade Separation Project will separate the roadway and the Union Pacific Railroad railroad tracks on Turnbull Canyon Road in the City of Industry/County of Los Angeles. Plans call for constructing a two-lane roadway overpass at Turnbull Canyon Road between Salt Lake Avenue on the north and Clark Avenue on the south to carry vehicles over the railroad tracks. Upon completion, it will eliminate traffic congestion, delays, potential train collisions, and train horn noise, as well as improve emergency response times and air quality.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Expect intermittent temporary closures of lanes or streets around the project area. Street parking and pedestrian access will be affected. Construction will involve trucks, tractors, and other equipment, causing noticeable noise, dust, and vibration. Motorists and pedestrians should obey signs and exercise caution near construction activities.

Phase 1: Salt Lake Avenue Closure July 2024 - April 2025 (See Detour Map)

-Salt Lake Avenue will be closed to traffic at the Turnbull Canyon Road intersection.

Phase 2: San Jose Bridge Closure July 2025 - October 2026

-Bridge over San Jose Creek will be rebuilt. Access to the businesses will be maintained on either side of bridge.

Phase 3: Turnbull Canyon Road Overpass Construction August 2025 - January 2027 -Turnbull Canyon Road will be closed to through traffic south of Salt Lake Avenue and north of Clark Avenue. Local access will remain for residents and businesses on Turnbull Canyon Road.

WHEN:

The project will begin July 2024. Most work will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 4 p.m., with weekend and night work as needed. Construction is expected to be completed by summer 2027.
